



Nestled in the center of Downtown Petersburg, the re-imagined Hotel Petersburg opens its doors in the Fall of 2024. The seven-story building blends artful design with 20th Century Second Renaissance Revival Style, featuring

original marble columns, a grand marble staircase with brass handrails, and fine terra cotta cornices with Italian-inspired scrolls. These architectural elements are meticulously restored, embracing the history and elegance of this beloved Petersburg treasure. Constructed in 1915, Hotel Petersburg operated as a hotel until a fire destroyed parts of the building in 1969. Local entrepreneur Nat Cuthbert leads the charge of the reinvented Hotel Petersburg.

A century in the making, the hotel's inviting yet grand entrance includes the original marble registration desk with wooden mail slots. Adjacent to the lobby, the center of activity, is a small foyer that was initially a ladies' writing room, along with the main dining room for the hotel and lobby bar. The upscale boutique hotel has 64 sleeping rooms: 40 standard kings, 19 double queens, and five suites with separate seating areas.

Hotel Petersburg once again becomes a gathering place for both locals and visitors. It is home to four unique dining and entertainment options: Shirley's, a full-service restaurant and bar serving seasonal fare; 20 West, a rooftop lounge with curated cocktails and sweeping city views; and The Boiler Room, a spirits bar with speakeasy vibes. There are also outdoor spaces, including a courtyard, offering a green space for guests to relax.

Cockade Room 60 standing | 48 seated

Sycamore Room

Once a bustling hub of activity when Hotel Petersburg opened in 1916, the Barbershop has been completely restored to reflect its original form, with barber stations with sinks and mirrors. A conversation starter, the Barbershop is located on the lower level near the Sycamore Room. The Barbershop serves as a breakout space or a stand-alone board room for up to 24 people.
